



An Extremely Rare Opportunity!

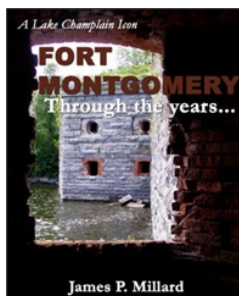
Tours of Historic FORT MONTGOMERY

(just north of the Alburgh/Rouses Point Bridge)

Experience a rare opportunity to explore the ruins of this historic Civil War era fort; the property is privately owned and access is prohibited to the public.

The tours will be guided by South Hero, Vermont's, **Jim Millard**, publisher of the popular **America's Historic Lakes** website and author of *Fort Montgomery: Through the Years* and *The Secrets of Crab Island* and **Roger Harwood**, President of the **Clinton County Historical Association** and sponsored by the **Rouses Point-Champlain Historical Society**.

There will be two tours: 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. and 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. The non-refundable fee for this tour is \$30 for Historical Society members and \$35 for non-members.

Each participant will receive an autographed copy of Jim Millard's book about the Fort. Reserve soon, the tours are expected to fill up fast. Tour will be held rain or shine.

No children under the age of 12 will be allowed on the tour for safety reasons.
